- 4 **Footpath project update:** 2 x parish councillors and the parish magazine editor are in the process of applying for a grant. This grant application is to request funds to go towards costs for signage for walking routes, places of interest, local amenities and an information leaflet for residents and visitors. This grant would cover 50% of any proposed costs only. The decision to this application will be made in March 2024.
- 5 **Update on solar power and recharging:** This information has been deferred until we receive confirmation from Drax our suppliers rate breakdowns. JP has confirmed to the committee that Scottish power has accepted our solar export.
- 6 To discuss the use of home carbon calculators and how to encourage residents to use this tool: It was confirmed by the assistant clerk that the WWF footprint calculator had been put on social media and at present residents do not wish to engage in this.
- 7 Discuss replacing street lights and fittings: M. Williams is looking to apply for a grant to replace all PC owned street lights to LED. The PC is waiting for further contractor quotations to proceed with this application. Deferred.
