- **Update on footpath and pump track:** M. Williams has applied for a grant from two organisations for grants to contribute to a footpath and or pump track. Decisions regarding designs and materials will be discussed once funding is in place.
- **Update on communicating with other groups:** M. Joannes has created a list of groups, businesses, organisations within the village. The intention is to invite all to a meeting before the end of this financial year to exchange ideas on how to support and improve services.
