Minutes of a meeting of the Youth and Community Committee held at 7.00pm on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2024 in the Jubilee Hall Meeting Room.

- **All those present**: Cllr M. Williams, M. Joannes, S. North, D. Seal + 3 village organisation representatives.
- **To agree previous minutes from** 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024 Proposer – M. Williams Seconder – D. Seal Show of hands
- To discuss and approve cookery class costs and confirm dates and times: It was resolved to proceed in using a catering contractor at £15.00 per hour for 5 hours per month. Classes to be run in 2 age groups, 10 13 years (5.30pm 6.30pm) & 14 16 years (7pm 8.30pm), booking a six week course. Food costs & start date to be confirmed when further information has been gathered.

To update committee of D. Day planning progress: It was confirmed that the Holy Trinity church will provide the bar, cake stall, strawberries and cream, tombola and any other fundraising stalls they require. It was resolved that any profits from their own stalls would go to the church. The Parish Council will source hot food, hot drinks, ice cream. These vendor's will be charged a one off £50.00 fee, payable before the event, which will pay for an entertainer. Any monies made on the day will be the vendors. Village organisations only will be offered fundraising stalls. All stalls must provide their own tables, chairs, gazebos.

It was resolved to contact the silver band for availability and cost to attend.

It was resolved D. Seal will contact the primary school to see if they wish to be involved. Ideas were, 1940's dress up, singing wartime songs.

It was resolved to leaflet each home with an invitation and include the resident survey at the same time.
